

SETTING UP APN ON THE PACKARD BELL TABLET


Guide to Setting UP an APN on the Packard bell Tablet

- 1. From the applications tray, touch Settings to open the Settings application.
- 2. Touch Networks & internet > Mobile Networks > Access Point Names.
- 3. Touch an existing APN to edit it. ...
- 4. When you're finished, press Menu or threedots at top right of the screen and touch Save.
- 5. If you created a new APN, touch it in the APNs screen to start using it.
- 6. You will only need to change two settings namely change NAME =MPUEDU.APN and APN=MPUEDU.APN like below screenshot

Quick verification to ensure user is connected to APN


Always double check that you have typed the APN correctly that is the only setting effective "mpuedu.apn"


Technically you can also verify that your device has been allocated an IP address in this range 10.32.0.1-10.32.255.254 if on your device IP address shows unavailable user won't be able to use the APN as it won't connect to the internet.




Visual Setup guidance

1. Select Settings.






3. Select SIMs.



4. Select Access Point Names.



5. Select New APN by touching the +





6. Enter Internet information and then press ok.

Next: Insert a new name: **DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION**.


Next: Insert a new APN name: mpedu.apn.






7. Next: Click save.
