 Arrival 15-30 mins	Welcome each learner. Ask them if they are cold or warm.	
 Health check		
 Morning Circle 10-15 mins	Ask the learners to compare today's weather with yesterday's. Ask them to say how it is the same or different. Learners make weather sentences using the words: today/yesterday/tomorrow.	
 Work Time Activities 45 mins	Mathematics focus Provide cotton wool, paper and glue for learners to work with. They make three clouds and arrange them from biggest to smallest.	Life Orientation/Creative focus Learners make igloos from Styrofoam peanuts (packaging material). They paste these onto cardboard.
 Small Group Time Activity 10-15 mins	Literacy focus Revise the short vowel sound 'i'. Point to items on the sound table and let learners name them with emphasising the initial sound. Learners read the pictures on page 45 of Workbook 2 from top to bottom and left to right. Ask them to place a counter on the words that begin with 'i' (igloo, insect, ink and in). Ask where the 'i' sound is heard in the words 'dig' and 'pig'.

 Music and Movement Ring	Sing the theme related song 'The Season Song' to the learners on page 72 of this Teacher's Guide. You can also use the LEAP audio lesson Term 2-09.	
 Outdoor Play	Include the activity below as one of your daily outdoor activities. Learners do relay races with a bean bag and an umbrella. The learner must walk while balancing the beanbag on his/her head and holding the umbrella as though it is raining. If the beanbag drops they stop put it back on their head and carry on.	
 Story Time	Read the book that learners made yesterday.
